**INSTRUCTIONS
FOR FILING
ANNUAL TAX REPORT OF GAS COMPANIES**

Please follow these instructions when preparing the Annual Tax Report:

1. All reports are due in this office no later than April 15th of each year.
2. Completion of cover page, page 1, and page 2 is required.
3. Follow the Uniform Systems of Accounts where applicable: however, this Division may require additional backup data for property and Gross Revenue not reported in the FERC Operating Report which is filed with the SCC Public Utility Accounting Division.
4. All property owned is to be reported at Original Cost or Fair Market Value where applicable.
5. **Make sure that all property is listed alphabetically, Cities first then Counties and Towns.** Also indicate the district, if any, in which the property is located (Refer to your current copy of the District Codes and include those codes in the columns provided on each page of the Tax Report. Remember to consolidate Annexed Areas after the first year.)
6. Enclosed is a real estate transaction form for reporting any land transactions which have occurred and have not been reported. Please complete the form IMMEDIATELY and return to this office by February 1st of each year.
7. Although Leased Land and Buildings will not be assessed, you are still required to give this office addresses of all these Leased Parcels. (Remember to report the dollars associated with Improvements made on Leased Property on page 4 on the same line as the Leased Parcel.)

Listed below is the Page and Class where your property should be reported:

1. Pages 3, 4 Class 1 - Land and Buildings
2. Pages 5, 6 Class 2 - Machinery and Equipment
3. Page 7 Class 3A - Automobiles and Trucks owned by the company listed in the locality where they are garaged. (Do not report leased vehicles)
4. Page 8 Class 3B - Furniture, Office equipment, Computers, Copy Machines, and any other related equipment.
5. Page 9 Class 4 - Mains, Transmission and Distribution

6. Page 10 Class 5 - Services
Page 10 Class 6 - Meters and Regulators
7. Page 11 Class 7 - Materials and Supplies, Plant Under Construction, etc.
8. Page 12 Class 8 - Merchant's Capital

If you have any other property than what is listed above and are uncertain where it should be reported, please contact this office (804) 371-9182.

Companies may file a computer printout in lieu of our regular printed report if the following stipulations are met:

- A. The entire report must be computerized and be the same size paper from cover to cover.
- B. Reports must be filed on 8 1/2" x 14" paper. Paper should be of a quality that will ensure its preservation as long as possible in its original form. Be sure to leave a one inch left margin for binding purposes.
- C. Your computer must follow the format of the tax reports that are mailed from this office to you in January of each year. The format must be exactly like each schedule, column for column and line for line. All columns must be labeled with their respective heading such as (A), (B) (C), etc. All pages and schedules must be totaled down and across.
- D. The duplicated copy of the computer generated tax report does not have to be of the same size and quality as the original computer generated copy that has to be filed.

NOTE: Please remember, the computer generated tax report is offered to you as an option and is **NOT** a requirement. If you should decide to exercise this option you are asked to submit a sample report for our review. Each incorporated GAS company doing business in the State of Virginia will receive **TWO** copies of this form. The President, or other proper officer, will furnish the information asked for as soon as possible, but not later than **APRIL FIFTEENTH**, and return both copies to the DIRECTOR, PUBLIC SERVICE TAXATION DIVISION, STATE CORPORATION COMMISSION, 4th Floor Tyler Building, 1300 East Main Street, Richmond, Virginia, 23219 or P.O. Box 1197, Richmond, Virginia, 23218.

Each question must be answered and SOME NOTATION must be made after every question to indicate that it has not been overlooked. Reference to returns of former years may not take the place of required entries.
