

June 30th Reporting Requirements

New Entrants and

Certain ILECs

General Instructions

These instructions are for the **June 30th** reporting requirements of the Competitive Local Exchange Carriers (“CLECs”) and Municipal Local Exchange Carriers (“MLECs”), combined “New Entrants,” and certain incumbent Local Exchange Carriers (“ILECs”). The Commission’s Rules Governing the Certification and Regulation of Competitive Local Exchange Carriers (“Local Rules”), 20 VAC 5-417-60 B, Reporting requirements for new entrants, defines the requirements.

Instructions, definitions, and/or a format are provided for each requirement. One copy of each schedule shall be provided to the Commission’s Division of Communications, **no later than July 31st** of each calendar year.

REQUIREMENTS

Access Lines

A report of the number of access lines, classified by residential and business (any public telephone lines should be reported as business), also identified by resold lines, Legacy UNE-P or Wholesale Advantage, UNE-Loop and Facilities Based.

Schedule 1, attached, provides an illustrative format that may be used to report access lines.

Geographic Areas Served

Each new entrant and certain ILECs shall provide a list of the geographic areas served within Virginia. This information shall include the identification of specific exchanges or geographic areas where service is actually being provided. These areas may be identified by CLLI codes, ILEC exchange, or post office zip codes.

Schedule 2, attached, provides an illustrative format that should be used to report geographic areas served.
