ON FUEL MIX AND EMISSIONS DATA FOR 2021**

Virginia Electric and Power Company (“Dominion Energy Virginia” or the “Company”) is an incumbent electric utility, as that term is used in the Virginia Electric Utility Restructuring Act, Va. Code §§ 56-576 to 56-596. Additionally, Dominion Energy Virginia is a local distribution company and, in 2021, was a provider of electricity supply service as defined by the Rules Governing Retail Access to Competitive Energy Services, 20 VAC 5-312-10 *et seq.*

By Final Order entered in Case No. PUE-2001-0013 on June 19, 2001, the State Corporation Commission of Virginia (“Commission”) adopted the Rules Governing Retail Access to Competitive Energy Services, 20 VAC 5-312-10 *et seq.* (the “Retail Access Rules”). On November 26, 2008, by Final Order in Case No. PUE-2008-00061, the Commission adopted revised Rules Governing Retail Access to Competitive Energy Services. Retail Access Rule 20 VAC 5-312-20(O) provides:

By March 31 of each year, the provider of electricity supply service shall report to its customers and file a report with the State Corporation Commission stating to the extent feasible, fuel mix and emissions data for the prior calendar year. If such data is unavailable, the provider of electricity supply service shall file a report with the State Corporation Commission stating why it is not feasible to submit any portion of such data.

Attached to this Report is a sample electric service bill showing the message that is appearing on the Company’s Virginia Jurisdictional customer bills.

The bill message provides information on Dominion Energy Virginia’s mixture of fuels used to generate electricity during 2021. The information is provided by percentage of total generation for coal, nuclear, natural gas, purchased power, renewables, oil, and Hydro. In addition, the bill message provides the Company’s 2021 total direct emissions data, in short tons per megawatt-hour generated, for sulfur dioxide and nitrogen oxides.

In 2021, the Company served over 2.7 million customers and generated 75,916,979 megawatt-hours (MWh) of electricity. Total direct emissions, based on tons per MWh of electricity generated, from the Company's facilities were 0.00005 tons of sulfur dioxide and 0.00009 tons of nitrogen oxides. The fuel source mix was 40.1% natural gas, 29.3% nuclear, 8.6% coal, 17.0% purchases, 2.7% Hydro, 2.0% renewable, 0.2% oil. The Company achieved its 14% RPS requirement.

As a result of the recent triennial rate review, the Virginia State Corporation Commission has approved refunds for Dominion Energy Virginia customers.
