## SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER SCHEDULING POST-TECHNICAL CONFERENCE COMMENTS

On December 16, 2024, the State Corporation Commission ("Commission") convened a Commissioner-led technical conference to explore current and anticipated future challenges presented by providing electric service to large-use, hyperscale customers. The technical conference was open to the public and was available for viewing via live webcast. A transcript of the technical conference will be available in the public record in this proceeding.

As previously set forth in the Commission's October 2, 2024 Scheduling Order and Notice of Technical Conference ("Notice Order"), the Commission believes it is important to ensure that all interested persons have the opportunity to submit comments responding to any or all of the topics discussed at the December 16, 2024 technical conference.

NOW THE COMMISSION, having hosted the technical conference on December 16, 2024, finds that all interested persons should be afforded an opportunity to submit post-technical conference comments, including any supporting materials, on or before January 17, 2025.

All comments shall reference Case No. PUR-2024-00144.
