ORDER FOR NOTICE AND COMMENT

On June 28, 2024, Roanoke Gas Company ("Roanoke" or "Company") filed an application ("Application") with the State Corporation Commission ("Commission") pursuant to § 56-603 *et seq.* of the Code of Virginia ("Code"), known as the Steps to Advance Virginia's Energy Plan (SAVE) Act, for approval of its annual update of its SAVE Rider, which seeks to implement a 2025 SAVE Projected Factor Rate ("2025 Projected Factor"), under the Company's approved SAVE Plan.<sup>1</sup> Pursuant to Code § 56-604 E, the Commission shall approve or deny, within 90 days, a natural gas utility's proposed SAVE rider adjustment.

In support of its Application, Roanoke states that, pursuant to the Commission's prior orders regarding its SAVE Plan,<sup>2</sup> the Company is filing this Application for approval of the 2025 Projected Factor and approval to implement the associated SAVE Rider rate, effective with the

first billing cycle in October 2024.<sup>3</sup> The Application notes that because the Company has not completed a full year under its current SAVE Plan, it is not proposing a true-up factor at this time.<sup>4</sup> Roanoke has requested a 2025 Projected Factor revenue requirement of \$1,526,900 for the upcoming SAVE Plan year<sup>5</sup> based on the Company's projected SAVE spend during the 2025 SAVE Plan year of \$9.13 million.<sup>6</sup> As proposed, the 2025 Projected Factor for residential customers would be a fixed monthly charge of \$1.78,<sup>7</sup> an increase of \$1.53 over the current monthly charge of \$0.25.<sup>8</sup>

NOW THE COMMISSION, upon consideration of this matter, is of the opinion and finds that the Company should provide public notice of its Application; that any interested persons should be afforded an opportunity to file comments or request a hearing on the Company's Application; and that Commission Staff ("Staff") should investigate the Application and file a report containing Staff's findings and recommendations.

To promote administrative efficiency and timely service of filings upon participants, the Commission will, among other things, direct the electronic filing of testimony and pleadings unless they contain confidential information, and require electronic service on parties to this proceeding.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

(1) All pleadings in this matter should be submitted electronically to the extent authorized by 5 VAC 5-20-150, *Copies and format*, of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure ("Rules of Practice"). Confidential and Extraordinarily Sensitive Information shall not be submitted electronically and should comply with 5 VAC 5-20-170, *Confidential information*, of the Rules of Practice. Any person seeking to hand deliver and physically file or submit any pleading or other document shall contact the Clerk's Office Document Control Center at (804) 371-9838 to arrange the delivery.

(2) Pursuant to 5 VAC 5-20-140, *Filing and service*, of the Commission's Rules of Practice, the Commission directs that service on parties and the Staff in this matter shall be accomplished by electronic means. Concerning Confidential or Extraordinarily Sensitive Information, parties and the Staff are instructed to work together to agree upon the manner in which documents containing such information shall be served upon one another, to the extent practicable, in an electronically protected manner, even if such information is unable to be filed in the Office of the Clerk, so that no party or the Staff is impeded from preparing its case.

(3) As provided by Code § 12.1-31 and 5 VAC 5-20-120, *Procedure before hearing examiners*, of the Commission's Rules of Practice, a Hearing Examiner is appointed to rule on any discovery matters that arise during the course of this proceeding and any motions *pro hac vice* that are filed. A copy of each filing relating to discovery matters or motions *pro hac vice* made with the Office of the Clerk in this matter shall also be sent electronically to the Office of the Hearing Examiners.<sup>9</sup>

Roanoke seeks approval of the 2025 Projected Factor and approval to implement the associated SAVE Rider rate, effective with the first billing cycle in October 2024. The Application notes that because the Company has not completed a full year under its current SAVE Plan, it is not proposing a true-up factor at this time. Roanoke has requested a 2025 Projected Factor revenue requirement of \$1,526,900 for the upcoming SAVE Plan year, based on the Company's projected SAVE spend during the 2025 SAVE Plan year of \$9.13 million. As proposed, the 2025 SAVE Rider rate for residential customers would be a fixed monthly charge of \$1.78, an increase of \$1.53 over the current monthly charge of \$0.25.

The details of these and other proposals are set forth in the Company's Application. Interested persons are encouraged to review the Company's Application and supporting exhibits for the details of these proposals.

TAKE NOTICE that the Commission may adopt rates that differ from those appearing in the Company's Application and supporting documents and may apportion revenues among

customer classes and/or design rates in a manner differing from that shown in the Application and supporting documents.

The Commission entered an Order for Notice and Comment that, among other things, directed the Company to provide notice to the public and provided interested persons an opportunity to comment on the Company's Application.

To promote administrative efficiency and timely service of filings upon participants, the Commission has directed the electronic filing of testimony and pleadings, unless they contain confidential information, and required electronic service on parties to this proceeding. (6) On or before August 21, 2024, Roanoke shall file proof of the service required by Ordering Paragraphs (4) and (5) with the Clerk of the Commission.

(7) On or before August 22, 2024, any interested person may submit comments on the Application by following the instructions on the Commission's website:

(11) The Staff shall investigate the Application. On or before August 22, 2024, the Staff shall file with the Clerk of the Commission a Staff Report containing its findings and recommendations and promptly shall serve a copy of the Staff Report on counsel to the Company and any respondents.

(12) On or before August 29, 2024, Roanoke may file with the Clerk of the Commission any response to any requests for hearing, in rebuttal to comments filed in this case, and to the Staff Report.

(13) Any documents filed in paper form with the Office of the Clerk of the Commission in this docket may use both sides of the paper. In all other respects, except as modified herein, all filings shall comply fully with the requirements of 5 VAC 5-20-150, *Copies and format*, of the Commission's Rules of Practice.

(14) The Commission's Rule of Practice 5 VAC 5-20-260, *Interrogatories or requests for production of documents and things*, shall be modified for this proceeding as follows: responses and objections to written interrogatories and requests for production of documents shall be served within five (5) calendar days after receipt of the same. In addition to the service requirements of 5 VAC 5-20-260 of the Rules of Practice, on the day that copies are filed with the Clerk of the Commission, a copy of the interrogatory or request for production shall be



served electronically on the party to whom the interrogatory or request for production is directed or the assigned Staff attorney, if the interrogatory or request for production is directed to the Staff.<sup>10</sup> Except as modified herein, discovery shall be in accordance with Part IV of the Commission's Rules of Practice, 5 VAC 5-20-240 *et seq.*
