

SUSPENSION OF INSURANCE UNDER Commercial Automobile Insurance Plan (CAIP)

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the VA Board of Governors of AIPSO conducted a new vote on the issue of permitting insureds to delete a vehicle or vehicles from their Commercial Automobile Insurance Plan (CAIP) policies. The Board has just approved a procedure to allow for the removal of vehicles from a commercial policy for a 60-day period upon the written request from an insured. The insured will be required to sign a vehicle deletion agreement that has been prepared by AIPSO Plan Counsel and approved by National Continental Insurance Company (NCIC). Insureds &/or the producer should contact NCIC's AIP Department at: 800-937-2247 to make this request. NCIC is aware of the VA Board's change of position on this issue.

Please be aware of the procedures that the Virginia Division of Motor Vehicles has outlined on their COVID-19 webpage for those who wish to remove coverage for vehicles under their motor carrier operating authority at <https://www.dmv.virginia.gov/general/#covid19.asp>. The Bureau strongly urges insureds to contact DMV before removing the insurance on any vehicles under your operating authority and follow DMV's instructions carefully.
