The SCC Division of Utility and Railroad Safety collects and forwards all complaint data regarding blocked crossing incidents to the Federal Railroad Administration to assist in justification of <u>any future congressional action</u>.

Should you encounter a blocked crossing or other incident: First, contact the railroad at the toll free number on the blue "ENS" sign, which is required by regulation to be posted at all grade crossings on each side of the track(s). Then, record the information from the sign, the number on the locomotive (if possible) and the amount of time the crossing was blocked to be added to the complaint information below.
