ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO: 9078**

**ORDER EXEMPTING THE REQUIREMENT OF FILING CERTAIN POLICY  
FORMS AND ENDORSEMENTS FOR COMMERCIAL INLAND MARINE INSURANCE,  
PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 38.1-279.32 [RECODIFIED AS §  
38.2-1903] OF THE CODE OF VIRGINIA.**

WHEREAS, It appearing to the Commission that the requirement of filing policy forms and endorsements for certain Commercial Inland Marine classes should be continued, pursuant to the provisions of Section 38.1-279.48:1 [recodified as § 38.2-317] of the Code of Virginia; and

WHEREAS, It appearing to the Commission that the requirement of filing policy forms and endorsements for certain Commercial Inland Marine classes should be exempted, pursuant to the provisions of Section 38.1-279.32 [recodified as § 38.2-1903] of the Code of Virginia, because such classes of risks, due to their inherent nature, involve substantial areas of exposure which require specially devised forms of coverage;

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED:

(1) That the requirement of filing policy forms and endorsements for the following Commercial Inland Marine classes shall be continued, pursuant to the provisions of Section 38.1-279-48:1 [recodified as § 38.2-317]:

- Accounts Receivable
- Cameras
- Camera and Musical Instrument Dealers
- Cleaners, Dyers and Laundries Bailee's Customers
- Equipment Dealers
- Film
- Floor Plan
- Installment Sales or Conditional Sales Floater
- Mail
- Mobile Agricultural Equipment & Livestock
- Motor Truck Cargo

Musical Instruments  
Physicians and Surgeons Equipment  
Signs and Street Clocks  
Theatrical Property  
Valuable Papers & Records

(2) That, except for the classes of Commercial Inland Marine insurance enumerated in (1) above, the requirement of filing policy forms and endorsements for all other Commercial Inland Marine insurance be, and it hereby is, exempted under the provisions of Section 38.1-279.32 [recodified as § 38.2-1903], by entry of this Order, until the further Order of the Commission, for the reason that such policy forms and endorsements therefor cannot practicably be filed before they are used in this Commonwealth;

(3) That Administrative Orders 8066, 8255 and 8345 be withdrawn as of the date of this Order; and

(4) That the policy forms and endorsements affected by this Order and hereafter used by insurers shall not be misleading or against public policy, and the Commission hereby reserves the right, either upon its own motion, or upon complaint, to make such examination or investigation with respect thereto as it may deem advisable or necessary in order to determine whether any policy form or endorsement affected by such exemption may be, or may become, misleading or against public policy.

IT IS, FURTHER, ORDERED That an attested copy hereof shall be sent to all licensed rate service organizations, the Bureau of Insurance, and to all insurance companies licensed to write Inland Marine insurance in this Commonwealth.
